



Craft Project: Pencil Picture Frame

Here's a fun project to do on the first day of school. It's the perfect way to show off those back-to-school pictures!

Supplies needed:

- No. 2 pencils
- School glue or a hot glue gun
- Washi tape
- Pink eraser
- Permanent marker

Step 1

Begin by making the sides of the frame. To do this, group three pencils and wrap decorative tape around to hold them together. Repeat to create each side.

Step 2

Beginning just below the metal portion of a pencil group, place a generous amount of glue. Then, lay another group of pencils at a 90° angle on top of the glue to create two sides of the frame. Repeat with each group until all four sides of the frame are created.

Step 3

Next, write a short message on the eraser with a permanent marker. Some examples you can use are:

- Back to School 2021
- Nash Elementary
- Jamie

Glue the pink eraser to the frame. Add a photo to your frame by adding small dots of glue to the front corners of your photo and attaching from the back of the frame. Be sure to allow glue on all pieces to dry completely before handling.

Hints & Tips

- Glue a paper clip to the back to hang your frame.
- Colored pencils make a colorful alternative to No. 2 pencils.
- Glue cap erasers in the corner of the frame in the shape of a tower as a decorative touch.
